

Letter Rules for the Multicultural Greek Council

When listing organizations for booklets or newsletters it is appropriate to go either alphabetically or by founding date. Any other way is seen offensive to our affiliate organizations. It is also always appropriate to list our organizations as Incorporated. It is seen disrespectful not to include this information. Most importantly NO ONE is allowed to wear our Greek letters no matter what! (ex: the aprons for the cooking channel during Greek week.) Our letters do not touch the ground and may not be written on the ground (chalking). Each organization has their own rules for the color of font and background for their letters. Alpha Phi Gamma Sorority Inc. –

- if our letters are going on clothing, we would prefer it to be spelled out.
- there are no specific colors our letters can or cannot be printed in.

Delta Xi Nu Multicultural Sorority Inc. –

Nobody but a sister of Delta Xi Nu may write our letters in Greek form. This means if another org wants our Greek letters on their posters, they need to ask one of us to write them on to the poster.

Nobody but a sister of Delta Xi Nu may wear our letters in Greek Form which means any T-shirts or paraphernalia to be had by teams can only have our written name.

If another org wants to write our sorority name in "English" on anything, it needs to be with our permission and the entire phrase "Delta Xi Nu Multicultural Sorority, Inc." This includes posters, banners, t-shirts, etc.

Our letters and written name can be written in nothing but red, white, black, silver, or gray unless approved by a sister.

Our letters and written name cannot be put on anything that is on the ground or intended to be stepped upon.

Lambda Sigma Upsilon Latino Fraternity Inc.-

Dear Amanda,

1. Only Brothers can wear letters
2. Our letters can only be on a **Baby Blue** or White Background
3. The actually letters can only be Baby Blue
4. Our letters CANNOT be written on the ground
5. Letters can only face the front
6. Our Shield can only be used with our permission

Lambda Theta Nu Sorority Inc. –

1. Only members of Lambda Theta Nu Sorority, Inc. can wear anything with our actual letters on them. If anyone else is going to be wearing shirts for example during Greek week, businesses, etc. it must be written out.

2. If we have shirts that have our Greek letters on them, the actual letters can only be in Burgundy, Silver, or White and the background has to be black, white, or light gray.
3. We cannot have our actual Greek letters on the back of our shirts
4. We cannot put our letters on undergarments, on pants, or shoes.
5. Our letters may not be used on any type of advertisements that involve drugs, alcohol, suggestive advertisements, or disrespectful events/photos of women.

Nu Alpha Kappa Fraternity Inc. –

The letters NAK may only be printed in the colors, red, white, bronze, or black. NAK letters on clothing or NAK paraphernalia may only be in the colors: red, white, and bronze. Only solid colors may be used. (No patterns or prints). Black may only be used as a **secondary color**. Black may be used as the **primary color** only in times of mourning or in representation of the Omega chapter. Only brothers of **Nu Alpha Kappa** may wear the letters.

Pi Lambda Chi Latina Sorority Inc. –

Sigma Lambda Beta International Fraternity Inc. –

-Our letters cannot be used on clothes, posters, advertisements, paraphernalia, etc. that others will be wearing, or using. In this case, our full organization's name should be used: Sigma Lambda Beta International Fraternity, Inc.

-When our letters are used, they should only be in White, Purple, or Black (if text).

-Our letters cannot be used in images with alcohol, drugs, scantily dressed women, or anything else that could be distasteful/offensive.

-Letters must stay together, i.e not broken/split by a buttoned shirt or only using one or two letters.

-They cannot be on anybody's back. (This shouldn't be a problem since if this arose the letters shouldn't be used, the full name should be spelled out.)

-Letters shouldn't be worn by anyone not a member of the fraternity, should be spelled out. This also applies to posters where there are multiple sets of Greek letters.

-If in doubt whether our letters can be used or not, the default should be to spell it out not use the letters. Or just ask.
