The Order of Omega is a leadership honor society for fraternal men and sorority women. Members are selected by an application process that assesses character, scholarship, service and leadership. To be eligible for membership, members must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher and have completed at least sixty (60) credit hours. It is a very competitive process and therefore, "the best of the best" are chosen to represent this prestigious Greek society.

The purpose of the Order of Omega, as stated in the national constitution, is threefold:

"First, to recognize those students who have attained a high standard of leadership in inter-Greek activities, to encourage them to continue along this line and to inspire others to strive for similar conspicuous attainment."

"Second, to bring together the most representative fraternity and sorority members and to create an organization which will help to mold the sentiment of the institution on questions of local and intercollegiate affairs."

"Third, to bring together members of the faculty, alumni and student members of the institution's fraternities and sororities on a basis of mutual interest, understanding and cooperation."

The Order of Omega members are expected to attend monthly meetings, maintain a GPA of 3.0 and attend the community service project (once per semester). Once accepted there is a onetime fee of \$70.00. This fee includes initiation materials, graduation cords and the national fee.
